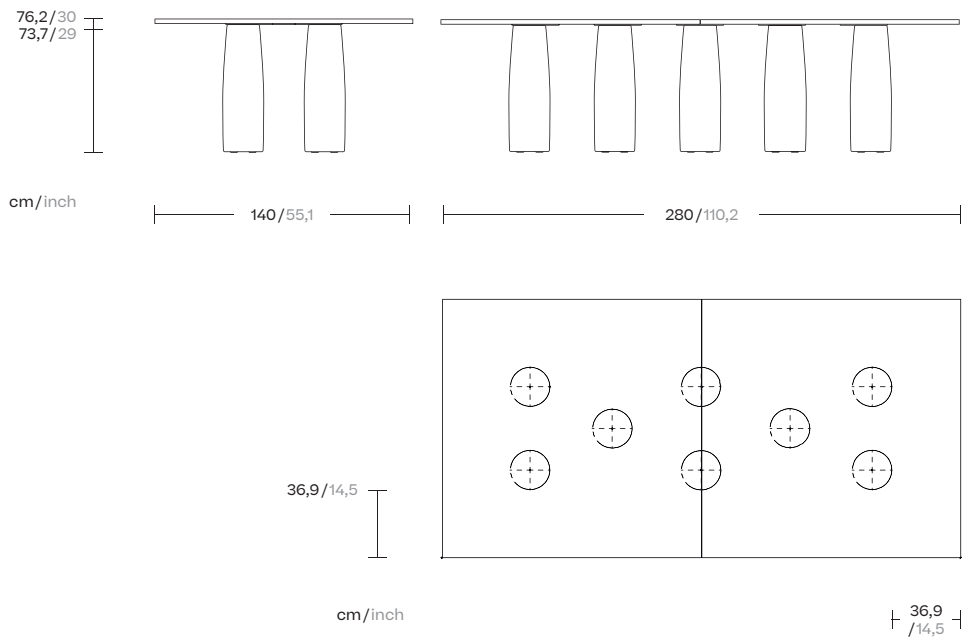

In this project, Mario Bellini took his inspiration from a basic elemental structure in architecture. His design emulated the colonnade of classical architecture, in which a sequence of columns supports a portico, in this case a table top. The base is a visually closed volume, despite being materially open.

When seen from a different viewpoint, perception changes completely, as the columns no longer overlap and the space appears empty.

Maintenance

Clean with mild soap using sponge or cloth. Be gentle while cleaning, do not scrub aggressively the fabric. Once cleaned please make sure you remove soap excess.

In case of aggressive stains clean with diluted household bleach.

Clean stains promptly. The longer it remains, more difficult will be to remove.

Once cleaned the fabric steam iron the fabric. Just use steam, be carefull NOT placing the iron directly in the fabric it will get damage.
