


Model 2129

The droplight luminaire designed in 1969 is a beautiful example of Gino Sarfatti's visionary design. A versatile, functional artwork that makes a powerful statement and brings attention to everything its light touches.

The intimate light provided by Model 2129 wraps the space in a warm ambience. The luminaire features a discreet counterweight and a large arcshaped arm in transparent methacrylate



that is attached to the ceiling and able to rotate 360 degrees horizontally. The cupshaped reflector is made of two lathed aluminium pieces painted white and caviar grey. Both the dowel for the ceiling fitting and the counterweight are made of painted brass.

In the re-issue, the original light source – an incandescent bulb – is replaced with LED lighting.
