CH23 HANS J. WEGNER

The CH23 Dining Chair, reintroduced in 2017, was one of the first chairs Hans J. Wegner designed exclusively for Carl Hansen & Søn in 1950. The CH23 incorporates many fine, sophisticated details: the elegant cruciform backrest cover caps, a double woven seat and arched rear legs to ensure optimal stability.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

Separate parts are processed on machine. The Chair is polished and assembled by hand and the paper cord is also weaved by hand.

DESIGNER

Danish architect Hans J. Wegner (1914-2007) is considered a pioneering furniture designer of the twentieth century. Often referred to as the master of the chair, Wegner created almost 500 in his lifetime – many of them considered masterpieces. Wegner was part of the spectacular generation that created what is today referred to as 'the Golden Age' of modern Danish design.
