CH78 I MAMA BEAR CHAIR HANS J. WEGNER

DESCRIPTION

An antidote to the often-heavy lounge chairs of Hans J. Wegner's time, was the sculptural silhouette of CH78. Also known as Mama Bear, it is defined by a series of inviting curves that offer up a warm embrace.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

The frame is bent and welded together. Then it is polished and assembled by hand. The chair consists of molded foam and is then upholstered by hand.

DESIGNER

Danish architect Hans J. Wegner (1914-2007) is considered a pioneering furniture designer of the twentieth century. Often referred to as the master of the chair, Wegner created almost 500 in his lifetime – many of them considered masterpieces. Wegner was part of the spectacular generation that created what is today referred to as 'the Golden Age' of modern Danish design.


